“WE HAVE ACCESS”

Hebrews 10:19-25

As our writer greets us with a good morning, He enters the bus to begin our journey back to that little village where we first began. What a blessing it has been to be in Jerusalem these past three months. It has been a great privilege and joy to explore the temple institute. While on our explorations of the temple, tabernacle, and Calvary, we got to analyze the tabernacle and all of its furnishing. We learned so much about God’s heart for His people. In addition to it being the week of Easter, our writer took us to Golgotha, where the fulfillment of prophecies and the will of God, all came to pass in Jesus. He is the one who made himself our perfect living sacrifice.

Last week our writer mentioned how we had been looking at chapter 10 verses 1 through 18 through three different lenses; The Tabernacle, The Covenant, and Doing the will of God. Our writer and Rabbi Rose reiterated the inefficiency of animal scarifies (vs 1-4), how the death of Jesus fulfilled the will of God (vs 5-10), and the perfecting of those being sanctified (vs 11-18).

This week our attention is focused on the study of our forever access to God, in heaven. The writer does this by reflecting on verse 12 and quoting “but this Man, after He had offered one sacrifice for sins forever, sat down at the right hand of God”. It is because of what Jesus Christ did on Calvary's cross that we are to have “...boldness to enter the holiest by the blood of Jesus, by a new and living way...” (10:19). Because of these truths, we can declare that:

- We must Hold Fast Our Confession
- We are to Stir Up Love and Good Works
- We are Not to Forsake the Assembling
